### Overview

The 330 Ambassadors are a select group of students from the Akron area chosen each year by the LeBron James Family Foundation to serve as role models and mentors to younger generations in the community, specifically through the Wheels for Education (3-5<sup>th</sup> grade) and Akron I Promise Network (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) programs. The Foundation is committed to creating and supporting events that demonstrate its dedication to the community and the 330 Ambassadors play an important role in making this happen. The Foundation seeks Ambassadors who embody LeBron's passion for education and service.

### The Role of an Ambassador

The 330 Ambassadors work alongside the Foundation throughout the entire year as a key component in the Wheels for Education and Akron I Promise Network programs. The primary purpose of the Ambassadors is to serve as role models and mentors to children in the community. As 330 Ambassadors, you will collaborate as a team to design an original community outreach project. Ambassadors function as an extension of LeBron by being highly involved with various events and initiatives put on by the Foundation.

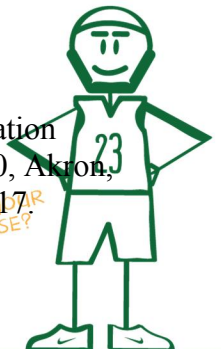
The Foundation is excited for a group of motivated high school students to serve as part of the *Eta Class (or 7<sup>th</sup> Class) of 330 Ambassadors*. These high school students must be currently enrolled within Akron Public Schools or St. Vincent-St. Mary with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Ambassadors are outgoing, team-players who are passionate and dedicated leaders. The Ambassador's role is year-round; the group meets during the summer for team building, assists with Training Camp through Akron Public Schools, and serves alongside the Foundation Team with special projects. During the school year, Ambassadors have direct, intentional interactions with the Wheels for Education and Akron I Promise Network participants through various community activities and other opportunities throughout Akron Public Schools.

### Expectations

The 330 Ambassadors are held to certain expectations as they serve in this leader/mentor role. It is important that all applicants are fully committed to abiding by these expectations. Expectations include: attendance at all meetings and events (unless excused prior to); actively participate community service project; consistent communication with leaders and fellow Ambassadors (via email, text, etc); refraining from posting inappropriate content through social media networking sites. All Ambassadors sign a commitment contract; if an Ambassador chooses to disregard the expectations set forth, he/she will be asked to step down from his/her position.

### Application Process
